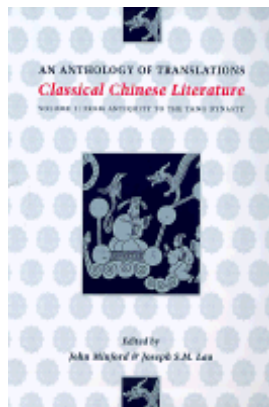

Each section starts with a "period introduction" that briefly gives a political, social, and philosophical background of the period.

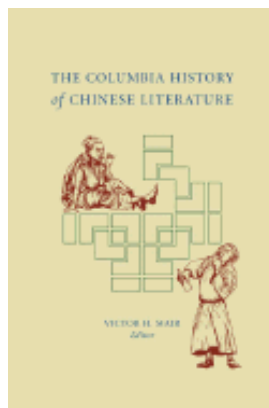
Classical Chinese literature : an anthology of translations *Minford, John*

- ◆ This is a compilation of literary criticism on Chinese literature. It has China's contemporary socialist perspective.

- ◆ This is an introduction to Chinese literature with historical periods and includes dominant genres. It focuses on literary themes and political influences on literary writings.

- ◆ It has literary criticism on classical and modern writings and it is a bridge between ancient and contemporary studies.
