FADIS (Fine Art Digital Imaging System) is a content management system initially developed by the Department of Fine Art at the University of Toronto.

The entire North Korean Photograph Collection has been digitized and uploaded on FADIS.

To view the collection online:

I) Enter FADIS using the following link:

- 2) Login via 'UofT Web Login' using your UTORid.
- 3) Click 'Search' from the top menu buttons.
- Search by the *title* of the photograph (complete list of titles available in the 'Online Finding Aid').

OR

- 5) Click 'Advanced Search' and select the 'North Korean Photograph Collection' from the 'Collection' drop-down button. Then press 'search.'
- 6) Click the preview thumbnail for an enlarged image and detailed bibliographic information.

ABOUT THE COLLECTION

This rare photograph collection of North Korea was made available by Mrs. Young Kahang, who donated 153 oversized print photographs in memory of her late husband Mr. Won-jin Kahang in August 2002. The collection itself originates from the late Mr. Kahang who had accumulated extensive materials relating to Kim II-sŏng, Kim Chŏng-il and North Korea in general.

CONTENTS

The collection consists of both colour and black and white photographs, ranging in size from $9\frac{1}{4}$ " (23.5 cm) to $19\frac{1}{2}$ " (49.5 cm) in width and 7" (17.8 cm) to $19\frac{1}{2}$ " (49.5 cm) in height. There are no negatives for the photographs. Each of the eight sets is accompanied by caption sheets indicating the title of each photograph and floor plans for displaying the images. The large size and the accompanying material of the collection suggest that it was part of some exhibition in the past.
